Option 3

Our famous BIKE 'N' HIKE is a wonderful way to spend a morning or afternoon. Rent a bike and cycle 10km along scenic county roads to Bennettsbridge(50mins). In Bennettsbridge you can visit Mosse's Pottery and Moth to a Flame candle makers then leave your bike and walk 10km back into Kilkenny along the stunningly beautiful Nore Valley Walk (2hrs).
